HAND STAND CLUB CADI User Guide

Congratulations! You are now the owner of one of the most innovative golf club stands in the market today- the Hand Stand Club Cadi or simply, the HAND. Whether on the range working on different shots with a variety of clubs or on the greens during a round, the HAND will keep your clubs high and dry and within easy reach.

Made of high-density polyethylene (HDPE) and supported by a threaded solid aluminum rod, the HAND is inserted in the ground at a slight angle and is then ready to support up to four clubs. HDPE is engineered to be safe, long lasting and weather-resistant. It will remain rigid under high temperatures, and is resistance to naturally occurring chemicals found in the soil.

The aluminum rod is threaded on one end and securely screws into a heat-pressed brass insert in the HAND for a tight yet reversible connection. The other end of the support rod is tapered to a point for easy insertion into the turf. It should be handled with care as the tip of the rod can be sharp and potentially cause injury if not used carefully and correctly.

The HAND can be stored in your bag along with the other clubs or taken apart and stored within the bag. It is recommended that both pieces be cleaned with mild soap and water as needed and the rod detached from the HAND for long term storage.

For a practice session or for a lesson, there is no need to take the entire bag along. A golfer can choose the HAND and up to five clubs and be ready to go. Insert the HAND into the ground at a convenient location and it will support four clubs while one is in use.

Throughout a round, it is oftentimes necessary to carry a chipping or pitching club along with the putter to the green. By inserting the HAND in proximity to the green and in the direction of the next hole, the unused club(s) can rest on it. After chipping onto the green, exchange the putter with the other club(s) onto the HAND. Your mates can also use the HAND to support their club(s) as they finish the hole. In this way, two goals are accomplished; first, the pace of play is maintained and enhanced because the group will exit in the direction of the next hole. The second goal is NCLB – No Club Left Behind! All too often, a club has been lost by forgetting to pick it up once the chipping or pitching is completed. Because the clubs were in the HAND, they were visible, were kept high and dry, were placed in the direction of the next tee box, and no club was left behind thanks to the **Hand Stand Club Cadi!**
